Dear Mr Young,

I write in response to your letter of 10 March 2022.

First, let me correct two significant inaccuracies in your letter: no leaflet was ever distributed on our campus, and no demonstration took place on our campus. No threatening stickers have been reported in our buildings or on our property.

You state that stickers have been placed 'near one of the Cardiff University campuses'. What you mean is that stickers have been placed on public property in a busy city centre.

Evidence of a protest that took place in the public realm should be reported to South Wales Police if you consider that this provides information concerning illegal activity.

I have been kept apprised of my senior team's response to the events that followed the publication of the open letter of 17 June 2021. I remain confident that the University has acted in the best interests of all of our staff and students, and that it will continue to do so. We will not be engaging in an independent inquiry.
